## Notification

In pursuance of directions of National Command & Operation Centre (NCOC) and Higher Education Department, Government of Punjab, vide notification No. SO(Admn)Misc./2020 dated 24.11.2020, in the wake of second wave of COVID-19, on-campus teaching will remain suspended from 26.11.2020 till 10.01.2021. The schedule of Online-cum-Distance Learning (ODL) classes, psychomotor performance, and on-campus examinations will continue as per following schedule:

- On-Campus Mid-Term Examination from 18.01.2021 to 23.01.2021
- On-Campus Psychomotor performance from 25.01.2021 to 05.02.2021
- Final Examination from 08.02.2021 to 12.02.2021
- Semester Break from 13.02.2021 to 21.02.2021
- Start of Spring-2021 Semester from 22.02.2021

**Session 2019, 2018:**

- ODL classes will continue till 24.12.2020
- Break from 25.12.2020 to 10.01.2021
- ODL classes from 11.01.2021 to 12.02.2021
- On-Campus Mid-Term Examination from 15.02.2021 to 20.02.2021
- On-Campus Psychomotor performance from 21.02.2021 to 12.03.2021
- Final Examination from 15.03.2021 to 20.03.2021
- Semester Break from 22.03.2021 to 26.03.2021
- Start of Spring-2021 Semester from 29.03.2021

It is further notified that:

1. Open **Text Book** quizzes will be conducted during ODL classes in order to encourage the students to read text books.

2. On-campus research activities of M.Sc./Master/MPhil. students will continue during the closure of on-campus teaching activities subject to adherence of COVID-19 imposed SOPs.
3. Hostels will be vacated by the students by tomorrow 26.11.2020. However, the foreign students as well as students from FATA, Gilgit Baltistan, Baluchistan, and Azad Jammu & Kashmir will be allowed to stay in hostels during closure of on-campus teaching. The research students of M.Sc./Master/M.Phil. and Ph.D. programs will also be allowed to stay in hostels. The hostel residents will strictly adhere to the COVID-19 imposed SOPs.
4. 50% teaching and no-teaching staff will perform on-campus duties in rotation. Rest of the staff will work from home. However, the Chairpersons and Heads of teaching and non-teaching departments may alter the percentage of staff for on-campus duty as per requirement of the respective department and office subject to adherence of COVID-19 imposed SOPs.
5. The Health Clinic's staff and other essential staff including Sweepers, Malis, and Security Guards will continue to perform their duties as per existing schedule. However, they will strictly follow the COVID-19 imposed SOPs.
