Prof. Dr. Atiq Ur Rehman Tariq has recently joined the Centre of Excellence in Water Resources Engineering, UET Lahore. He got his PhD from TU Delft, Netherlands (World's Second Top Rank University in Civil and Structural Engineering). He has extensive experience in teaching, research, and leadership in Pakistan, Europe, Asia, and Australia. He played a major role to establish the Civil Engineering Departments at COMSATS Abbottabad and CUST Islamabad.

He was one of the recognized experts who played a role in obtaining PEC's Washington Award member status by introducing industry-oriented Outcome-based education through complex engineering problems at the national level. Before joining the Centre, he played an important role in Victoria University's transition to a block mode of instruction.
